4-on-4 Rules

1. Games will be 15 minutes in length. The clock stops the last minute.
2. Guaranteed a minimum of two games
3. Man to man defense ONLY!
4. There will be one timeout per team.
5. Substitute only when the ball is being taken out of bounds. No substituting on the run.
6. 1 referee per court. Refs will call fouls. Their decision is final. It is expected that players, coaches, and fans will be respectful and courteous to our referee volunteers.
7. Games start every 15-20 minutes. Be on time and ready to go! We will not wait for late teams.
8. No free throws. The following rules pertain to fouls:
 - a) On non-shooting fouls the ball will be taken out of bounds. Under one minute on a non-shooting foul, 1 point is given to the fouled team and possession changes. **AFTER THE 12TH TEAM FOUL 1 POINT IS GIVEN TO THE FOULED TEAM AND THEY RETAIN POSSESSION.** On the third foul under one minute, 1 point is given to the fouled team and they retain possession.
 - b) On shooting fouls, the fouled team is given 1 point if fouled on a 2-point shot, and 2 points if fouled on a 3-point shot. Possession then changes. The under one minute rule also applies here.
 - c) On intentional fouls, 1 point is given to the fouled team and they retain possession.
 - d) On flagrant or technical fouls the fouled team will receive 2 points plus possession of the ball. There may also be a cool down period put into effect by the discretion of the referee.
7. Awards will be given for 1st place teams.
8. 20 point mercy rule with 3 minutes remaining.

***A reminder that this tournament is for the development of basketball fundamentals, positive sportsmanship, and the development of our future young men and women athletes both on and off the basketball court. We expect that the coaches and adults attending the tournament will help to teach our youth these very important life skills by demonstrating positive sportsmanship as well.**
